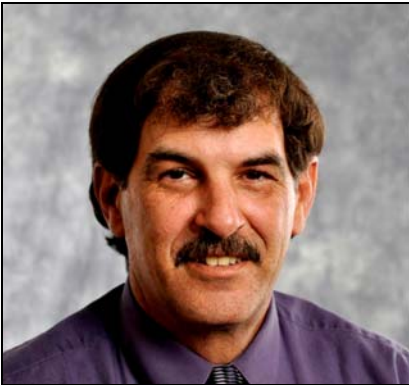
Prior to joining Duro-last Schaffer was a production coordinator at Grede Foundries in Vassar, Michigan.
